



# 2024 BY THE NUMBERS - ITEMIZED

#### A Continual Pattern of Growth

Since opening in 2018, Foster Together's annual growth has been undeniable. 2024 proved no exception with double digit growth in the number of children served and a 25% increase in the number of free deliveries to children placed with new foster families.





# CHILDREN SERVED BY YEAR

Especially in the last 3 years, Foster Together has seen yearly transformative growth, minus a slight dip during 2020 owing to the pandemic, The total number of children in St. Louis area foster care served by Foster Together since opening in 2018 is **4,947**.

# **FUNDRAISING INITIATIVES**

As a non-profit, Foster Together is constantly striving to grow its revenue streams through donor programs, fundraising events, community partnerships, and grant writing.

#### Circle of Hope



In November 2024, Foster Together kicked off a campaign to build our Circle of Hope - a monthly donor initiative to secure ongoing, reliable donations. That campaign added an additional nine new monthly donors for an extra \$495/month to Foster Together's revenue. Those monthly donors added to our existing ongoing donations gives Foster Together a foundation of \$16,320/year we can count on as we fund existing programs and build new ones. We will continue to develop this program further in 2025 to give even more stability to our operations.

#### **Fundraising**



Foster Together's largest annual fundraiser continues to be Rock of Ages, a musical bingo event that brings in funds from attendee ticket sales, corporate sponsorships, and silent auction items. 2024 saw the largest amount raised yet, almost \$31,000 from 350 attendees. 2025's event is scheduled for March 8, with the anticipation of raising an even larger amount from increased seating capacity and sponsorships.

### **Community Partnerships**



Foster Together continues to grow exponentially through community partnerships. 12 large organizational partnerships brought in **\$69,969** in funds donated to our programs.

An additional 58 small business and individual partnerships added to Foster Together's resources through in-kind donations, donation drop-off locations, collection drives, and more.

#### Grants



Foster Together has been incredibly blessed to have received over **\$60,750** in funds from grant applications that were awarded for 2024. This amount has increased an astonishing 1600% from the first year Foster Together received a grant in 2019. Identifying new grant opportunities and maintaining already identified sources will continue to be a mainstay for Foster Together's funding.



# PR & SOCIAL MEDIA IMPACT & AWARENESS

Foster Together's active and thriving brand awareness through PR and social media presence are a big part of helping spread the word about who we are and what we do. In 2024, we had huge mass media exposure locally through awards given to our organization's team, in addition to record breaking numbers for Meta reach, visits, and follows. With the introduction of our TikTok channel, we saw huge impact not just in engagement, but in direct donations, opening a new audience and revenue stream for us.

# 2024 PR HIGHLIGHTS AND SUCCESSES



2024 saw Foster Together's Executive Director, Laura Storm named the winner of St Louis' KTVI-TV Fox 2's **Remarkable Women!** This gave Foster Together massive exposure through both Fox 2's TV channel, as well as its social media, and lent immense credibility to the work being done through Foster Together.

Foster Together was also chosen as St. Louis City SC's Exceptional Neighbor, giving the organization incredible exposure both at the game and through STLSC's social media channels.





# GOOGLE BUSINESS PROFILE/WEBSITE

Having a robust online presence is crucial to being able to connect with families looking for resources for children in foster care. We see most people discovering us through Google searches, where the majority of the traffic comes from

searching "foster" from their mobile device. 4th quarter saw an almost 30% increase in GBP interactions of 1,142. **Our website has seen a dramatic 98% increase in site traffic from 2023 to 2024 - to almost 30,000 site visits in 2024.**
